The EFG Project: The Basics

- Initiated by ACE and the Europeana Foundation
- EFG funded by the European Commission under the eContent plus programme
- September 2008 to August 2011
- Main project outcome is the web portal "European Film Gateway", expected to be publicly available end of May 2011
- 16 European film archives and cinémathèques contribute content to EFG, 5 further partners complete the EFG consortium



Objectives

- Build a "digital showcase" for collections in European film archives and cinémathèques
 - Films and film clips (esp. non-fiction)
 - Images: posters, photos, stills and set photographies, designs and drawings etc.
 - Text material: reviews, correspondence, censorsip and rating visa etc.
- Central access point to federated digital collections and repositories
- Link film archives to Europeana






Europeana Logfile Analysis (Oct 2009-Sep 2010):

- Users are 10 times more likely to click on a "video item" than on a "text item"
- Users are 15 times more likely to click on a "video item" than on an "image item"
- Still only 2 % of all material in Europeana is audio or video




EFG as "Aggregator" for Europeana






















Content: What can be found on the EFG?

• 80 % images

- film stills, set photos, posters, laterna magica slides, set and costume designs, advertising material etc.

> 10 % videos

- mainly newsreels, early fiction films, documentaries, advertising and travel films etc.

< 10 % texts</p>

- early censorship documents, rare books from the precinema era, periodicals, correspondence, production papers, screenplays etc.

EFG presents content from the 17th century until today, the majority of the material dates from the first half of the 20th century.




