

Cataloguing objective for WP3

To supply the EFG Portal with well structured metadata of high quality from 16 different archival databases





Cataloguing challenge for wp3

No common standards for

- metadata schemas
- cataloguing rules
- vocabularies in film archival domain
- The same person or film work can come from different databases.





Results of cataloguing survey

- Archives are inspired by FIAF
 Cataloguing Rule and AACR but have developed local adjustments.
- Archives have different ways to distinguish between two or several persons with the same name.
- Different technical solutions dictate the way of cataloguing names and titles.





EFG cataloguing - decisions

- The EFG archives **has not** applyed common cataloguing rules for film titles as well as for names of persons and corporate bodies in their databases.
- EFG has established general guidelines on how to clean and enrich data for EFG needs: "EFG Data enrichment and cleaning guidelines".





Important data for the EFG database:

- Person view
- Preferred name
- Type of activity / function
- Date, country, place of birth
- Date, country, place of death
- Other names
- Link to biographic entry on local website





Local data enrichment

- Individual cataloguing plan for each archive
- Currently the archives report their cataloguing work done.

August 2011:

D3.2 Final report on type and quantity of archival resources tagged.





Data cleaning and enrichment in local databases

- √ 740.000 enriched and cleaned records
- Addition of metadata to existing records
- Creation of new records
- Harmonization and standardization of records
- √ 370.000 established relationships
- Local ID of the digital object record was embedded into the local authority record.
- ...and vice versa.





Concrete examples of enrichments and cleaning in the archives

Persons:

- Enrichments of functions, dates of birth and death
- Cleaning of doublets and spelling mistakes.

Film work:

- Enrichments of genre, category, and further titles
- Cleaning of doublets and spelling mistakes





Cataloguing on EFG level

EFG Backend Tools

- Vocabulary Checker
- Authority File Manager
- Metadata Editor





Functions:

- Upload and ingest XML records
- Create new records in the EFG database
- Edit more data to existing records
- Establish relationships between authority records and digital objects.




