Aggregation aims

EFG metadata schema
(925.000 XML records):

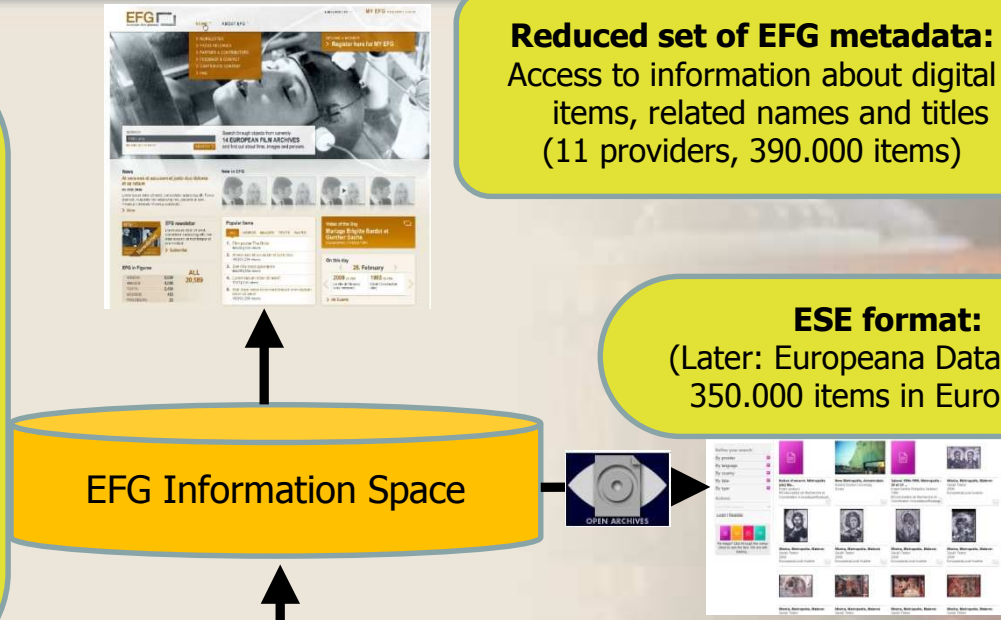
Aggregation of filmographic and biographic data as well as data on digital archival resources

2nd idea of EFG: Create a common registry of film works and persons active in the film domain => Approach: unique EFG authority files

Filmographic data in EFG: 120.000 film works, 240.000 persons, 26.000 corporations, + groups, + events

Reduced set of EFG metadata:
Access to information about digital items, related names and titles
(11 providers, 390.000 items)

ESE format:
(Later: Europeana Data Model)
350.000 items in Europeana

Challenges

- 1) **Doublets**: Information about the same person or film work can come from different data sources due to numerous European co-productions
- 2) **Diverse quality of metadata** on persons, film works and corporations delivered by partner archives:
 - **Authority records**
 - not all partners manage them
 - 14 partners delivered unique records for film works, 8 for persons, 5 for corporations
 - Name and title data came normalised and not normalised
 - **Cataloguing practices**
 - no common cataloguing rules applied at partner archives
 - records varying in level of detail on information provided
 - no archive references its names and titles to an external authority file

Challenges

- **Metadata structures**
- no common formats to deliver information on names and titles
- most partners use in-house or an EFG adapted format
- only 1 partner supplied this kind of information in a standardized format (EAC)

3) **Data management** issues: Activities to match & merge name and title data to EFG authority files must be in line with the ingestion, data cleaning and enrichment activities

- **Clean doublets in local and EFG database**
- **Enrich name and title records (locally and in EFG)**
- **Develop semantic technology tools (EFG backend tools)**
- **Establish reliable ingestion and metadata editing workflow**

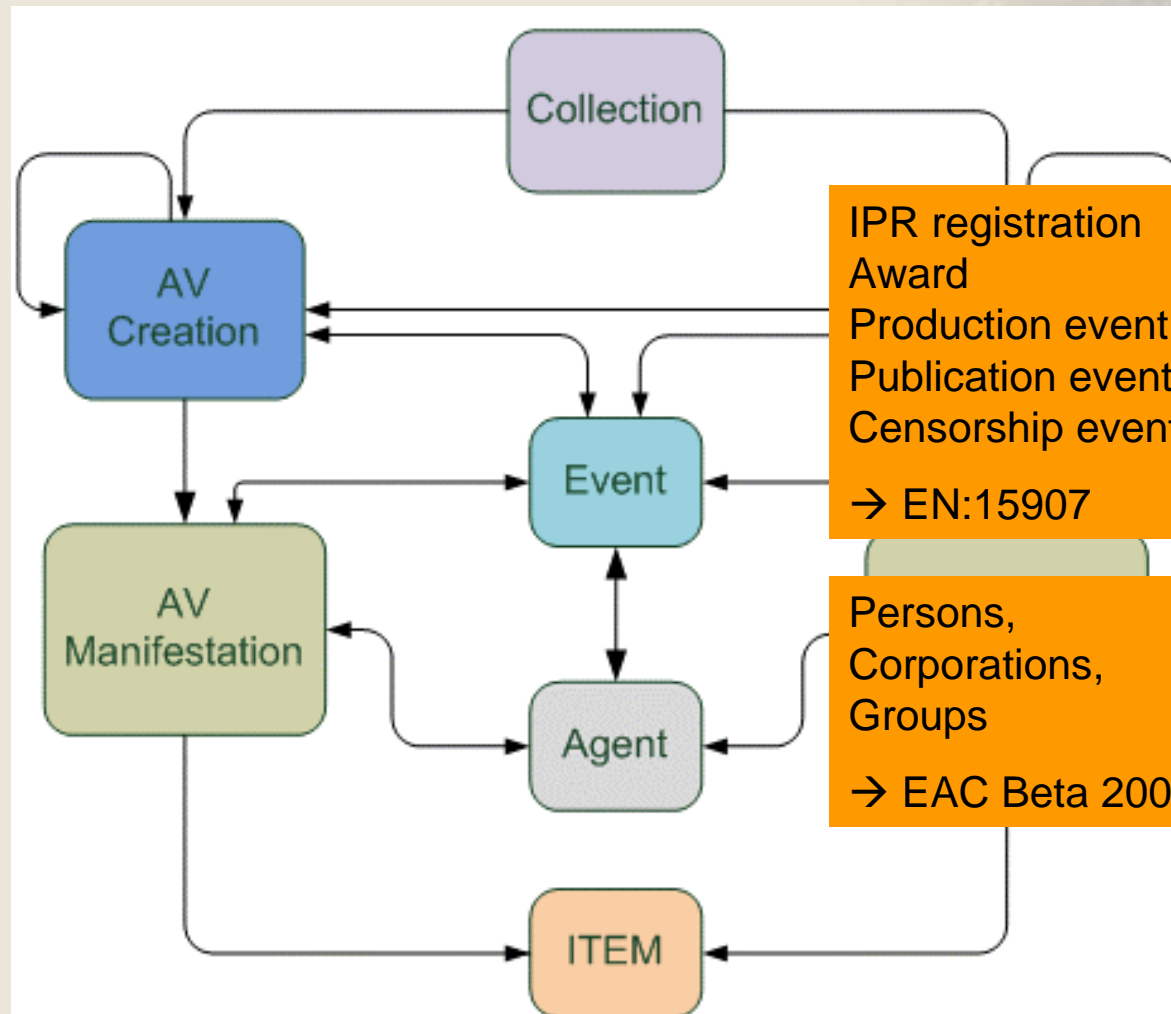

EFG metadata schema



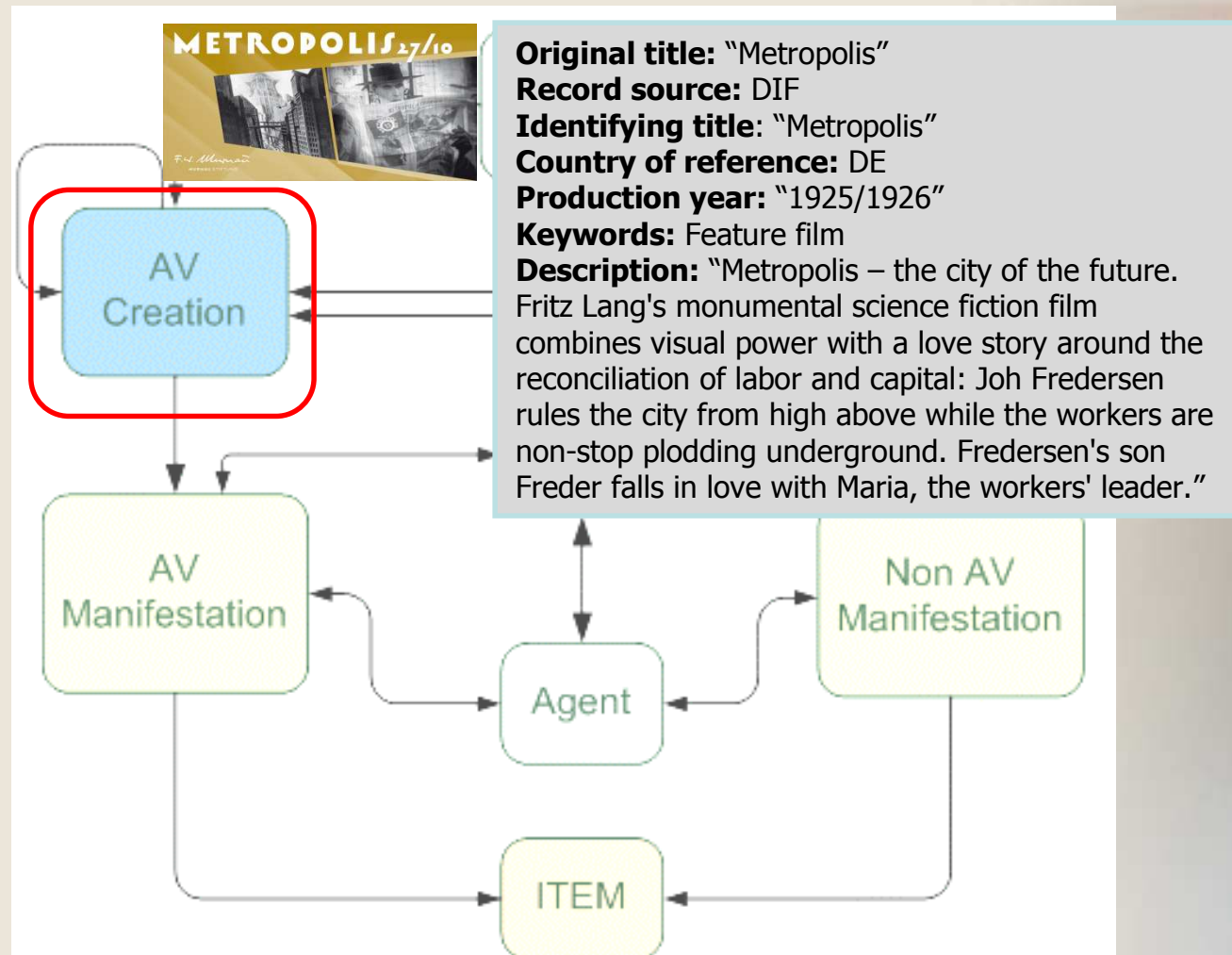

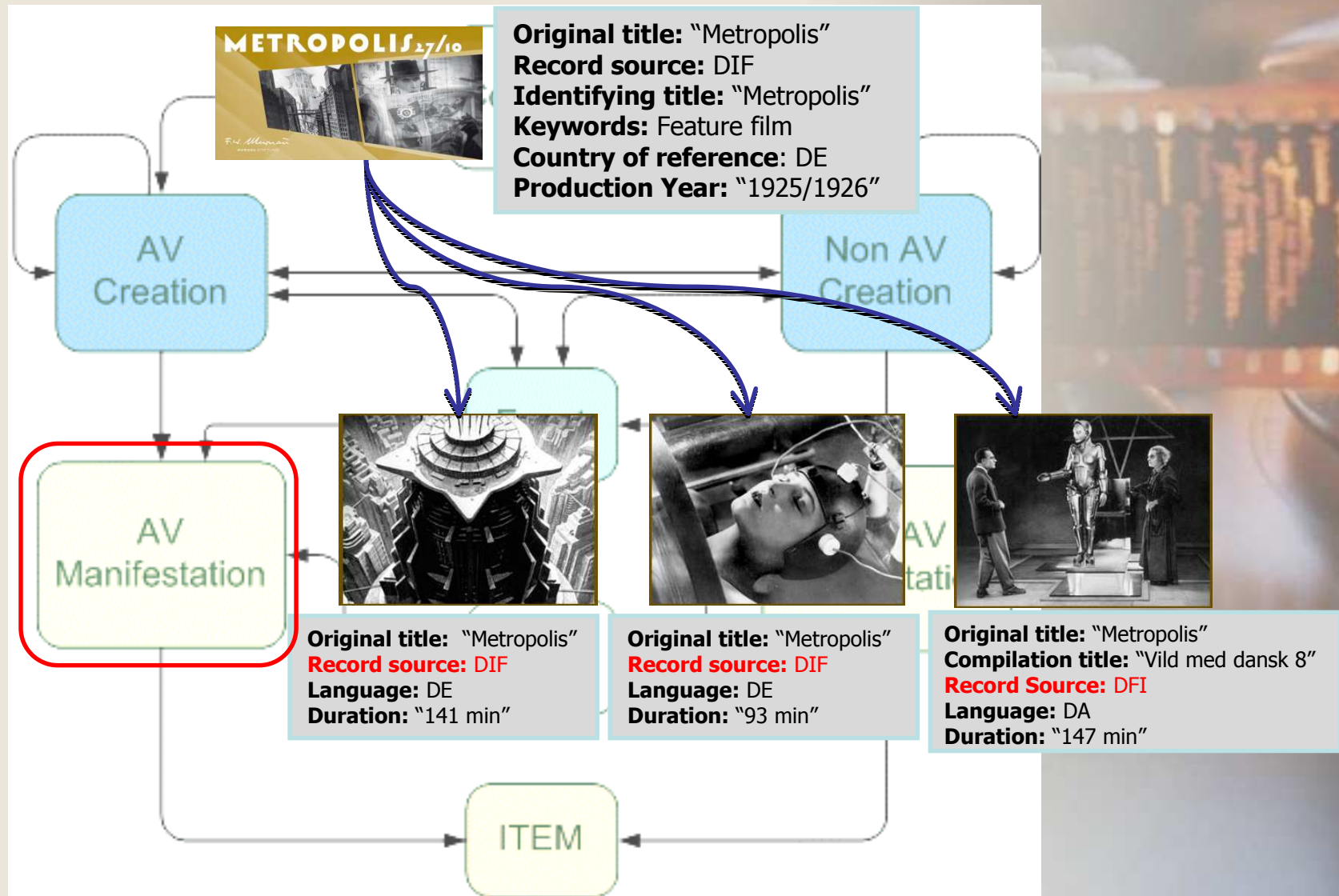

Authority File Manager

- Data cleaning in EFG
- Identifies doublet records of the same film work or person (active in the film domain) in EFG Information Space
- Allows partners also to detect doublets in their local databases
- Allows to merge doublet records to authority records
- Uses basic concepts of „Match & Merge“ applied by librarians

Role of filmographic data in EFG portal

Example: Vampyr, DE FR 1938

- Portal is not a common filmography but a search engine for digital material held in Europe's film archives
- Filmographic data used to contextualise digital objects
- Shows only limited set of filmographic data held in EFG (names, titles which are directly related to digital objects)
- Initial portal concept: to exploit more extensive filmographic data for the functions that contextualise the digital material

Derfor giver han blod til en transfusion, forhindrer den syge kvinde i at tage gift, befrier hendes søster, der er bundet til en seng, og drager til sidst bort med hende. Desuden er det lykkedes ham at standse den forbandelse, der hvilede over egnen, ved sammen med tjeneren at drive en jernpæl gennem en gammel kvindelig vampyrs hjerte. Derefter sorger tjeneren for, at hendes medskyldige, lægen, bliver kvalt - i mel (fra "Carl Th. Dreyer født Nilsson" af Martin Drouzy, 1982).
A young man, Allan Gray, arrives at a countryside inn. At the very same evening an unknown man pays him a visit and asks him for help to save a young girl who is in great danger. As it turns out the girl is the unknown man's sister. Shortly after the visit the unknown man - resident at a great manor - is murdered, and Allan Gray has to come to the young girl's rescue all alone. He gives blood to a transfusion, prevents the sick woman from taking poison, sets her sister who is tied to a bed free, and finally sets out with her. Furthermore he has succeeded in putting an end to the curse that has been upon the locality; together with the servant he has driven an iron pile into the heart of an old female vampire. The servant makes sure that her accomplice, the doctor, suffocates - in flour.

Achievements

- Set up and tested workflows how authority records can be created in a common database with the help of semantic technology tools developed by EFG
- Increased quality of person and film work records in archives' **local databases** (partners use the AFM tool to clean their doublets)
- Increased quality of name and title records in the **EFG database** (normalisation, cleaning and enrichment, represented data in unique format)
- Laid groundwork for a common filmography
- Created an understanding what data quality means in the scope of authority file building and maintenance within film archival community and beyond

Lessons learnt

- Maintenance of common registry of filmographic authority files cannot be assured by EFG (project expires in Aug 11) → need to follow-up on this task in other initiatives
- Projects like EFG can only come up with experiences and recommendations how authority files can be created and managed in the film archival domain
- Match & merge heterogeneous data from 16 different data sources was not first priority in this pilot project → AFM tool to be further refined
- Further work needs to be done to create unique references for the names and titles managed by film archives and by EFG

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After EFG: Towards a common filmography?

*“The common filmography will serve as an authority file of European **film works**, **persons** and **corporate bodies**, providing the highest possible precision in information and content retrieval”.* (Quote from EFG Description of Work)

Common registry of film works with persistent IDs is still task for film archives

- Could be built upon filmographic data aggregated in EFG
- More standardisation (FIAC Cataloguing Commission - rules, CEN Technical Committee - structure)

Should be matched and linked with authority files from national libraries in bilateral projects (e.g. GND in Germany)

- Film archives have to manage their persons in authority files
- Integrate unique IDs of library catalogues into film archival catalogues

Can be integrated in and linked with authority files from national libraries (e.g. GND in Germany).

- Should be postponed
- Requires more film-historic research
- Film archives would have to create authority files for corporations
